Message to Visitors - 6th July 2020

On the 6th July, the 5 mile restrictions will be lifted in Wales, and we are expecting that many of you will be occupying your holiday homes, and from the 13th July we will have visitors in the self catering accommodation as well. You will find that some parts of the Community are yet to re-open, and many of the events normally held over the coming months will not take place this year. Thankfully, no one contracted the virus in this community, but we do have residents who will be shielding until at least the middle of August. Please be considerate as you walk/travel around the Community. With visitors coming to Marloes & St. Brides from all parts of the United Kingdom and possibly beyond, we are all at risk of infection if someone arrives who does not yet know they are infected. The STAY ALERT message is still relevant. We only have one general hospital to serve Pembrokeshire residents and also visitors

The National Trusts have re-opened the car park at Martins Haven, but Skomer Island is not open in July. The Coastal Path is now open. The newly upgraded Marloes Sand Car Park is opening in stages over the coming weeks. St. Peter's & St. Brides Churches and Moriah Chapel, Marloes are still closed, as is the Community Recreation Area and the Clock Tower.

Marloes Village Stores & Post Office is open for business, but ask that visitors respect the Wales social distance requirements which have been observed by the local communities since the Coronavirus Emergency began.

- Two people only inside the premises at any time. People to respect Welsh social distancing requirements inside and outside.
- If you are part of a larger group, please arrange for one person only to enter the premises.
- Goods can be ordered by e-mail or telephone, and will then be delivered to your accommodation.
